
**ORDER**

**AND NOW**, this *30th* day of April, 2020, pursuant to the Supreme Court's April 28, 2020 "Emergency Order of Statewide Judicial Administration Applicable from May 1, 2020, through June 1, 2020," Bucks County Emergency Order No. 2020-14 is hereby amended as follows:

Consistent with the Orders of the Supreme Court of Pennsylvania and this Court, which, in pertinent part, tolled judicial timelines during the period of the judicial emergency, any judicial deadline governing the timeliness of the filing by the Agency of a termination petition either pursuant to the Adoption and Safe Families Act (i.e., 15 of the last 22 months pursuant to 42 U.S.C.A. § 675(5)(e)(ii) and 42 Pa.C.S. § 6351(f)(9)) or for purposes of involuntary termination of parental rights under the Adoption Act, 23 Pa.C.S. §§ 2511(a)(1), (2), (4), (5), (6), and (8), is **TOLLED** from the date of March 19, 2020, through May 8, 2020.

In all other respects Emergency Order No. 2020-14 shall remain as entered.
